On the 9th and 12th of April we invite you to two **Musical Salons**. The location is the Lili Boulanger Hall at Bredg 25. We have many students who are happy to share what they are playing! Learning to stand on stage, dare to show themselves and make themselves heard - these are important steps in the development of a young person. As a concert-giving music school, this is part of our educational focus.

During the Easter break, we can offer an incredibly beautiful lunch concert in collaboration with Allhelgonakyrkan on April 16th: at 12.15 our **harp teacher, Sanni Korpelainen, will give a solo concert.** The same day in the evening we will play our traditional concert **Stilla men inte Tyst**. Here you can sink into beautiful music played by our students on harp, guitar and cello. The concert starts with a small devotion at 18.00.

During the Easter break, we will also arrange, as usual: **LEGS LIMUS Extensive Grades Exams**. Here, young people with special interests can sharpen their skills in scales, arpeggios, sight-reading and aural training.

Then comes May 1st in Maria Magdalena Church where we this time will be arranging no less than four student concerts in one day: **Lilla och Stora Pianorama and two Ensemble concerts.** A real music festival where you can also bring your own picnic basket! Special courses next academic year:

Some of you will be invited to supplementary **theory courses** and others will be invited to the **Music Cheque Ensemble**. Advanced string students will be invited to **LIUS**. All of these are additional courses that we subsidize ourselves. The more you learn, the more fun it is to make music.

What else is there to say?

When we inaugurated the Lili Boulanger Hall, MP Emma Ahlström Köster from the Moderate Party gave a speech. On March 24th, we will be visited by MP Camilla Brodin from the Christian Democratic Party (Kristdemokraterna). She is also curious about how we work, what our goals are and what challenges we are exposed to in terms of finances. Among other things, we will address the VAT issue - but also things like the fact that Lund Municipality refuses to co-finance our young people's concert activities.
